Bryan was a brilliant, whimsical soul who touched many lives. He loved his plant research passionately. We will miss him dearly.

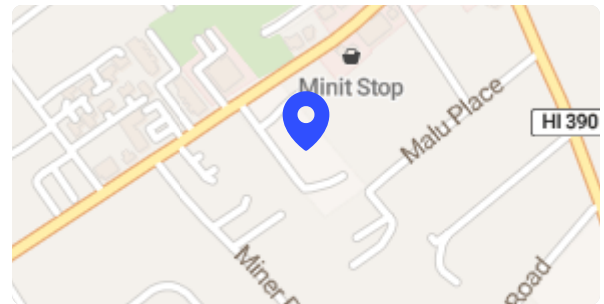

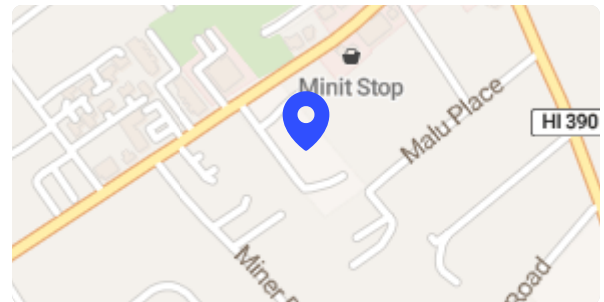
