Tulsi was a bright, enthusiastic, and intelligent home schooled student who loved her family and her friends. She will be terribly missed by everyone who knew her.

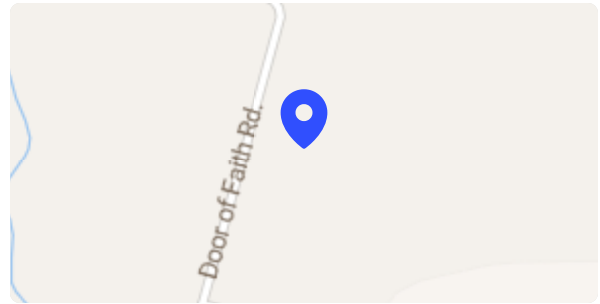

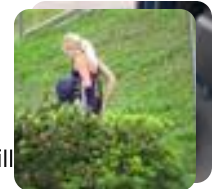
