## **Carlito Guerrero Ranjo**

In Heaven, he will join his brothers, Abraham & Alfredo Ranjo.

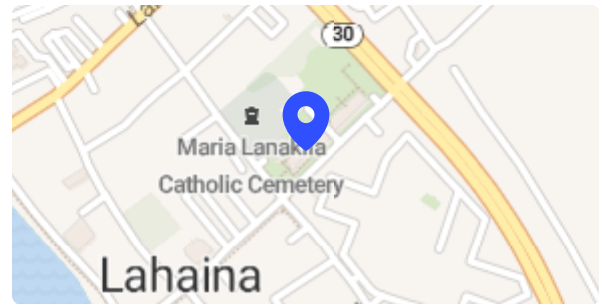
