From his humble beginnings in Keokea, and through his exceptional work ethic, Bill was able to achieve his career goal of becoming a Certified Public Accountant. He graduated from Baldwin High School as salutatorian and went on to Drake University on an academic scholarship. After serving as an officer in the Army, he was the first CPA on Maui, and retired as partner from Coopers and Lybrand, a national CPA firm. 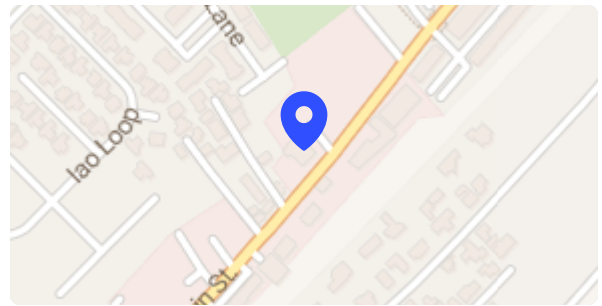
